**Synopsis:** Use of biodiesel fuel in state vehicles. Requires the use of blended biodiesel fuel in state vehicles when feasible.

## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1032

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 5-22-5-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005]: Sec. 8. (a) This section does not apply  
3 to a political subdivision.  
4 **(b) As used in this section, "blended biodiesel" has the meaning**  
5 **set forth in IC 6-3.1-27-2.**  
6 ~~(b)~~ **(c)** As used in this section, "ethanol" means agriculturally  
7 derived ethyl alcohol.  
8 ~~(c)~~ **(d)** As used in this section, "gasohol" means gasoline that  
9 contains:  
10 (1) at least ten percent (10%) ethanol; or  
11 (2) ethyl tertiary butyl ether (ETBE) additives derived from  
12 ethanol.  
13 ~~(d)~~ **(e)** As used in this section, "gasoline fueled vehicle" refers to a  
14 vehicle that is capable of using gasoline to fuel its primary motor.  
15 ~~(e)~~ **(f)** As used in this section, "vehicle" includes the following:  
16 (1) An automobile.  
17 (2) A truck.

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- 1 (3) A tractor.
- 2 ~~(f)~~ (g) Except as provided by subsection ~~(g)~~; (i), a governmental
- 3 body shall whenever possible purchase gasohol to fuel the gasoline
- 4 fueled vehicles owned or operated by the governmental body.
- 5 (h) Except as provided by subsection (i), a governmental body
- 6 shall whenever possible purchase blended biodiesel fuel to fuel the
- 7 diesel fueled vehicles owned or operated by the governmental body.
- 8 ~~(g)~~ (i) The following vehicles are exempt from the requirements of
- 9 subsection ~~(f)~~: subsections (g) and (h):
- 10 (1) A vehicle that is leased by the governmental body for thirty
- 11 (30) days or less.
- 12 (2) A vehicle whose official operating manual, as issued by the
- 13 manufacturer of the vehicle, contains a statement that the use of
- 14 gasohol or blended biodiesel fuel will damage the engine of the
- 15 vehicle.
- 16 (3) A vehicle that:
- 17 (A) is primarily powered by a diesel or an electric motor; or
- 18 (B) can use only propane, compressed or liquified natural gas,
- 19 or methanol as its fuel source.
