<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> The bill repeals the expiration of the statute providing for counseling and debt restructuring negotiations for farmers.

Effective Date: July 1, 2005.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Under current law, the Commissioner of Agriculture administers a grant program to provide counseling for financially troubled farmers. The grants are made to individuals, corporations, limited liability companies, associations, organizations, or other entities. The program is set to expire on July 1, 2006. Under the bill, the program would be continued.

Background: The Farm Counseling Program is funded with state General Fund appropriations. The expenditure history follows.
