Summary of Legislation: The bill provides for the Superintendent of Public Instruction to be appointed by the Governor. The bill repeals a statute relating to the residency of candidates for election for Superintendent of Public Instruction. The bill deletes a provision describing the term of office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Effective Date: July 1, 2005.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Under the bill, the Superintendent of Public Instruction would be appointed by the Governor after January 11, 2009. The salary of the Superintendent would be fixed by the Governor. State expenditures for salary and salary-related fringe benefits would be affected if an appointed Superintendent's salary were set at a rate more or less than the \$79,400 required under current law.
