**Summary of Legislation:** The bill requires the State Board of Education (the Board) to develop standards and guidelines concerning cheerleading safety in schools.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2005.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** *Summary:* The Board could adopt the necessary rules, as required under the bill, within the course of a scheduled business meeting.

*Background Information:* Through August 2004, the Board has met seven times. The Board currently has 11 members including the Superintendent of Public Instruction. Current board members are entitled to an annual salary of \$2,000 plus salary per diem and reimbursement for travel expense.
