**Summary of Legislation:** The bill creates the Interim Study Committee on Interstate Tracking of Violent Felons and Registered Sex Offenders to study issues relating to:

- (1) the feasibility of entering into an agreement with other states to track the interstate movement of violent felons and sex offenders;
- (2) the use of the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) data base to track violent felons and registered sex offenders;
- (3) the feasibility of having states maintain their own criminal history data base; and
- (4) other issues related to tracking the interstate movement of violent felons and sex offenders.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2005.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The budgets associated with interim study committees are determined by the Legislative Council. During the last interim, interim study committee budgets were \$8,000 for committees with 15 or fewer members and \$15,000 for committees with at least 16 members. All costs incurred will be paid from appropriations to the Legislative Council.
