MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1842 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
- 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
- 3 homeland security.
- 4 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 5 paragraph and insert:
- 6 "SECTION 1. IC 3-5-4-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 7 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE**
- 8 **JULY 1, 2005]: Sec. 11. A voter may not be required to show either**
- 9 **of the following as a condition to being admitted to the polls or to**
- 10 **voting:**
- 11 **(1) A driver's license issued under IC 9-24-11.**
- 12 **(2) An identification card issued under IC 9-24-16.**
- 13 SECTION 2. IC 3-5-8-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 14 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005]: Sec. 2. ~~(a)~~ The statement required by
- 15 section 1 of this chapter must contain the following:
- 16 (1) A statement of the qualifications that an individual must meet
- 17 to vote in Indiana, including qualifications relating to registration.
- 18 (2) A statement describing the circumstances that permit a voter
- 19 who has moved from the precinct where the voter is registered to
- 20 return to that precinct to vote.
- 21 (3) A statement that an individual who meets the qualifications
- 22 and circumstances listed in subdivisions (1) and (2) may vote in
- 23 the election.
- 24 (4) A statement describing how a voter who is challenged at the
- 25 polls may be permitted to vote.

- 1 (5) The date of the election and the hours during which the polls
 2 will be open, as required by 42 U.S.C. 15482.
- 3 (6) Instructions on how to vote, including how to cast a vote and
 4 how to cast a provisional ballot, as required by 42 U.S.C. 15482.
- 5 (7) Instructions for mail-in registrants and first time voters under
 6 IC 3-7-33-4.5 and 42 U.S.C. 15483, as required under 42 U.S.C.
 7 15482.
- 8 (8) General information on voting rights under applicable federal
 9 and state laws, including the right of an individual to cast a
 10 provisional ballot and instructions on how to contact the
 11 appropriate officials if these rights are alleged to have been
 12 violated, as required under 42 U.S.C. 15482.
- 13 (9) General information on federal and state laws regarding
 14 prohibitions on acts of fraud and misrepresentation, as required
 15 under 42 U.S.C. 15482.
- 16 (10) A statement informing the voter what assistance is available
 17 to assist the voter at the polls.
- 18 (11) A statement informing the voter what circumstances will
 19 spoil the voter's ballot and the procedures available for the voter
 20 to request a new ballot.
- 21 (12) A statement describing which voters will be permitted to vote
 22 at the closing of the polls.
- 23 **(13) A statement that a voter may not be required to show**
 24 **either of the following as a condition to being admitted to the**
 25 **polls or to voting:**
- 26 **(A) A driver's license issued under IC 9-24-11**
 27 **(B) An identification card issued under IC 9-24-16.**
- 28 ~~(13)~~ (14) Other information that the commission considers
 29 important for a voter to know.
- 30 ~~(b) The voter's bill of rights is not required to contain the~~
 31 ~~information described in subsection (a)(5), (a)(6), (a)(7), (a)(8), and~~
 32 ~~(a)(9) before January 1, 2004."~~
- 33 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
