# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1519 be amended to read as follows:

1           Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new  
2 paragraph and insert:  
3           SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005] (a) **Before July 1, 2006,**  
4 **the office of Medicaid policy and planning shall adopt rules under**  
5 **IC 4-22-2 that define the criteria and process used by the office of**  
6 **Medicaid policy and planning to determine if a developmentally**  
7 **disabled individual (as defined in IC 12-7-2-62) qualifies for the**  
8 **level of care provided by an intermediate care facility for the**  
9 **mentally retarded (ICF/MR). The rules must provide that a**  
10 **developmentally disabled individual (as defined in IC 12-7-2-62)**  
11 **qualifies for the level of care for an intermediate care facility for**  
12 **the mentally retarded (ICF/MR) if the individual's disability**  
13 **results in substantial functional limitations in at least three (3) of**  
14 **the following areas of major life activities:**  
15           (1) Self-care.  
16           (2) Understanding and use of language.  
17           (3) Learning.  
18           (4) Mobility.  
19           (5) Self-direction.  
20           (6) Capacity for independent living.  
21 (b) **Before July 1, 2006, the office of Medicaid policy and**  
22 **planning shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 that define the criteria**  
23 **and process used by the office of Medicaid policy and planning to**  
24 **determine the number of hours of care that a developmentally**  
25 **disabled individual (as defined in IC 12-7-2-62) needs in a**  
26 **supervised group living setting. The rules must provide that a**  
27 **developmentally disabled individual (as defined in IC 12-7-2-62) in**

1       **the following types of supervised group living settings needs the**  
2       **following hours of care per resident day:**  
3               **(1) Intensive training, six (6) hours.**  
4               **(2) Developmental training, eight (8) hours.**  
5               **(3) Basic development, ten (10) hours.**  
6               **(4) Medically fragile, twelve (12) hours.**  
7               **(5) Child rearing, eight (8) hours.**  
8               **(6) Child rearing with specialized programs, ten (10) hours.**  
9               **(7) Small residence with behavior management for children,**  
10              **twelve (12) hours.**  
11       **Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.**
