MR. SPEAKER:

Your Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security, to which was referred Senate Bill 32, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 35-47-1-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005]: Sec. 7. "Proper person"
5 means a person who: ~~does not~~
6 (1) **does not** have a conviction for resisting law enforcement
7 under IC 35-44-3-3 within five (5) years before the person applies
8 for a license or permit under this chapter;
9 (2) **does not** have a conviction for a crime for which ~~he~~ **the**
10 **person** could have been sentenced for more than one (1) year;
11 **(3) does not have a conviction for a crime of domestic violence**
12 **(as defined in IC 35-41-1-6.3), unless a court has restored the**
13 **person's right to possess a firearm under IC 3-7-13-5;**
14 **(4) is not prohibited by a court order from possessing a**
15 **handgun;**
16 ~~(5)~~ **(5) does not** have a record of being an alcohol or drug abuser

1 as defined in this chapter;
2 ~~(4)~~ **(6) does not** have documented evidence which would give rise
3 to a reasonable belief that ~~he~~ **the person** has a propensity for
4 violent or emotionally unstable conduct;
5 ~~(5)~~ **(7) does not** make a false statement of material fact on ~~his~~ **the**
6 **person's** application;
7 ~~(6)~~ **(8) does not** have a conviction for any crime involving an
8 inability to safely handle a handgun;
9 ~~(7)~~ **(9) does not** have a conviction for violation of the provisions
10 of this article within five (5) years of ~~his~~ **the person's** application;
11 or
12 ~~(8)~~ **(10) does not** have an adjudication as a delinquent child for an
13 act that would be a felony if committed by an adult, if the person
14 applying for a license or permit under this chapter is less than
15 twenty-three (23) years of age."
16 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
