DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-10-8-7.9; IC 27-8-14.9; IC 27-13-7-14.1.

Synopsis: Bone density testing coverage. Requires bone density testing coverage under certain group health benefit plans.

Effective: July 1, 2005.

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SENATE BILL No. 150



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 5-10-8-7.9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2005]: **Sec. 7.9. (a) As used in this section, "bone density testing"**
4 **means a radiological or radioisotope procedure or other procedure**
5 **that is approved by the federal Food and Drug Administration and**
6 **performed for any of the following purposes:**
7 (1) **Identifying bone mass.**
8 (2) **Detecting bone loss or disease.**
9 (3) **Determining bone quality.**
10 (b) **As used in this section, "covered individual" means a woman**
11 **who is at least forty-five (45) years of age and who is:**
12 (1) **covered under a self-insurance program established under**
13 **section 7(b) of this chapter to provide group health coverage;**
14 **or**
15 (2) **entitled to services under a contract with a prepaid health**
16 **care delivery plan described in section 7(c) of this chapter.**
17 (c) **A self-insurance program established under section 7(b) of**



1 this chapter to provide group health coverage must provide a
2 covered individual with coverage for bone density testing.

3 (d) A contract with a prepaid health care delivery plan
4 described in section 7(c) of this chapter must provide a covered
5 individual with bone density testing.

6 (e) The coverage required by subsection (c) and the services
7 required by subsection (d) may not be subject to dollar limits,
8 deductibles, copayments, or coinsurance provisions that are less
9 favorable to a covered individual than the dollar limits,
10 deductibles, copayments, or coinsurance provisions applying to
11 physical illness generally under the self-insurance program or
12 contract.

13 (f) The coverage required by subsection (c) and the services
14 required by subsection (d) must be provided in addition to benefits
15 specifically provided for x-rays, laboratory testing, or wellness
16 examinations.

17 SECTION 2. IC 27-8-14.9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
18 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
19 JULY 1, 2005]:

20 **Chapter 14.9. Coverage for Bone Density Testing**

21 **Sec. 1. (a) As used in this chapter, "accident and sickness**
22 **insurance policy" means an insurance policy that:**

- 23 (1) provides at least one (1) of the kinds of insurance
- 24 described in IC 27-1-5-1, Classes 1(b) and 2(a); and
- 25 (2) is issued on a group basis.

26 (b) The term does not include accident only, credit, dental,
27 vision, Medicare supplement, long term care, or disability income
28 insurance.

29 **Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "bone density testing" means a**
30 **radiological or radioisotope procedure or other procedure that is**
31 **approved by the federal Food and Drug Administration and**
32 **performed for any of the following purposes:**

- 33 (1) Identifying bone mass.
- 34 (2) Detecting bone loss or disease.
- 35 (3) Determining bone quality.

36 **Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "insured" means a woman who**
37 **is at least forty-five (45) years of age and who is entitled to**
38 **coverage under an accident and sickness insurance policy.**

39 **Sec. 4. (a) An insurer shall provide an insured with coverage for**
40 **bone density testing under any accident and sickness insurance**
41 **policy that the insurer issues in Indiana or issues for delivery in**
42 **Indiana.**

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1 (b) The coverage that an insurer must provide under this
2 chapter may not be subject to dollar limits, deductibles, or
3 coinsurance provisions that are less favorable to an insured than
4 the dollar limits, deductibles, or coinsurance provisions applying
5 to physical illness generally under the accident and sickness
6 insurance policy.

7 (c) The coverage that an insurer must provide under this
8 chapter is in addition to benefits specifically provided for x-rays,
9 laboratory testing, or wellness examinations.

10 SECTION 3. IC 27-13-7-14.1 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
11 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
12 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005]: Sec. 14.1. (a) As used in this section,
13 "bone density testing" means a radiological or radioisotope
14 procedure or other procedure that is approved by the federal Food
15 and Drug Administration and performed for any of the following
16 purposes:

- 17 (1) Identifying bone mass.
- 18 (2) Detecting bone loss or disease.
- 19 (3) Determining bone quality.

20 (b) A health maintenance organization that is issued a certificate
21 of authority in Indiana shall provide bone density testing to a
22 female enrollee who is at least forty-five (45) years of age as a
23 covered service under a group contract that provides coverage for
24 basic health care services.

25 (c) The coverage that a health maintenance organization must
26 provide under this section may not be subject to a contract
27 provision that is less favorable to an enrollee than a contract
28 provision applying to physical illness generally under the health
29 maintenance organization contract.

30 (d) The coverage that a health maintenance organization must
31 provide under this section is in addition to benefits specifically
32 provided for x-rays, laboratory testing, or wellness examinations.

33 SECTION 4. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005] (a) IC 5-10-8-7.9, as
34 added by this act, applies to a self-insurance program or a contract
35 with a prepaid health care delivery plan that is established, entered
36 into, delivered, amended, or renewed after June 30, 2005.

37 (b) IC 27-8-14.9, as added by this act, applies to an accident and
38 sickness insurance policy that is issued, delivered, amended, or
39 renewed after June 30, 2005.

40 (c) IC 27-13-7-14.1, as added by this act, applies to a health
41 maintenance organization contract that is entered into, delivered,
42 amended, or renewed after June 30, 2005.

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
