DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: Violent crime interstate compact. Creates the interim study committee on interstate tracking of violent felons and registered sex offenders to study issues relating to: (1) the feasibility of entering into an agreement with other states to track the interstate movement of violent felons and sex offenders; (2) the use of the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) data base to track violent felons and registered sex offenders; (3) the feasibility of having states maintain their own criminal history data base; and (4) other issues related to tracking the interstate movement of violent felons and sex offenders.

SENATE BILL No. 390

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005] (a) As used in this
- 2 SECTION, "committee" refers to the interim study committee on
- 3 interstate tracking of violent felons and registered sex offenders
- 4 established by this SECTION.
- 5 (b) There is established the interim study committee on
- 6 interstate tracking of violent felons and registered sex offenders.
- 7 The committee shall study:
- 8 (1) the feasibility of entering into an agreement with other
- 9 states to track the interstate movement of:
- 10 (A) violent felons; and
- 11 (B) registered sex offenders;
- 12 (2) issues relating to the use of the National Crime
- 13 Information Center's data base to track the interstate
- 14 movement of violent felons and registered sex offenders;
- 15 (3) the feasibility of having states create and maintain a
- 16 national criminal history data base that would operate
- 17 independently of the National Crime Information Center; and
- 18 (4) other issues relating to tracking the interstate movement



- 1 **of violent felons and sex offenders.**
- 2 **(c) The committee shall operate under the policies governing**
- 3 **study committees adopted by the legislative council.**
- 4 **(d) The affirmative votes of a majority of the voting members**
- 5 **appointed to the committee are required for the committee to take**
- 6 **action on any measure, including final reports.**
- 7 **(e) This SECTION expires January 1, 2006.**
