DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 10-14-2-4; IC 16-31-3-7.

Synopsis: Emergency management and medical services. Makes certain changes to the law concerning state emergency management and emergency medical services.

Effective: July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning public safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 10-14-2-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005]: Sec. 4. The agency shall do
- 3 the following:
- 4 (1) Coordinate the state's emergency plans.
- 5 (2) Serve as the coordinating agency for all state efforts for:
- 6 (A) preparedness for;
- 7 (B) response to;
- 8 (C) mitigation of; and
- 9 (D) recovery from;
- 10 emergencies and disasters.
- 11 (3) Administer this article and IC 16-31.
- 12 (4) Perform duties assigned to the agency by the governor.
- 13 SECTION 2. IC 16-31-3-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 14 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005]: Sec. 7. The commission may
- 15 not withhold certification from a person providing emergency medical
- 16 services that include extrication and rescue services because the person
- 17 is not affiliated with ~~a~~ **any of the following:**



- 1 (1) A hospital.
- 2 (2) A law enforcement agency. or
- 3 (3) A fire department.

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
