DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 8-23-3-11.

Synopsis: Federal highway funds. Requires the department of transportation to retain 70% of federal highway funds received by the state in certain categories and distribute 30% of the funds to units of local government.

Effective: July 1, 2005.

HOUSE BILL No. 1801



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning utilities and transportation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 8-23-3-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 3 1, 2005]: **Sec. 11. (a) The department shall divide federal highway**
- 4 **funds received by the state between the state and local units of**
- 5 **government. The department shall:**
- 6 **(1) retain seventy percent (70%) of the federal funds; and**
- 7 **(2) distribute thirty percent (30%) of the federal funds to**
- 8 **units of local government.**
- 9 **(b) Federal funds from the following highway programs shall be**
- 10 **distributed as required by subsection (a):**
- 11 **(1) Interstate maintenance program.**
- 12 **(2) National highway system.**
- 13 **(3) Highway bridge program.**
- 14 **(4) Recreational trails program.**
- 15 **(5) State planning and research.**
- 16 **(6) Surface transportation program.**
- 17 **(7) Congestion mitigation and air quality improvement**

- 2 **(8) Metropolitan planning funds.**
- 3 **(9) Redistribution funds.**
