**IMPACT:** State & Local

**Summary of Legislation:** This bill removes the requirements that a person or entity that acquires a defibrillator ensure that the users have completed certain courses and have enlisted a physician for medical direction.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2006.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The bill would no longer require persons or entities, including state agencies and local units of government, that provide defibrillators on their premises to provide training for employees in the use of the equipment.
