Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that when a court grants probationary driving privileges to certain persons, the order must include the requirement that for six months the person may not operate a motor vehicle unless the motor vehicle is equipped with a functioning certified ignition interlock device.

Effective Date: July 1, 2006.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: The cost of installing, monitoring, and calibrating an ignition interlock device is generally between \$60 and \$75 per month every month. The cost is paid by the person ordered by the court to have the device installed (IC 9-30-8-1).
