**Summary of Legislation:** This bill provides that when a court grants probationary driving privileges to certain persons, the order must include the requirement that for six months the person may not operate a motor vehicle unless the motor vehicle is equipped with a functioning certified ignition interlock device.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2006.

**Explanation of Local Expenditures:** The cost of installing, monitoring, and calibrating an ignition interlock device is generally between \$60 and \$75 per month every month. The cost is paid by the person ordered by the court to have the device installed (IC 9-30-8-1). The Bureau of Motor Vehicles reported the number of probationary DUI licenses issued between 2003 and 2005 as the following.
