**Summary of Legislation:** (Amended) The bill eliminates statutory provisions permitting race horses to race while being treated with certain medications. It requires the Horse Racing Commission to consider model rules approved by the Association of Racing Commissioners International before adopting rules permitting the use of any medication. It repeals the definition of "test level". It also repeals a provision concerning restrictions on race horses that are known to have bled from their nostrils.
