DIGEST OF HB 1367 (Updated January 23, 2006 3:20 pm - DI 107)

Citations Affected: IC 34-30.

Synopsis: Interim study committee on insurance and liability concerns of small nonprofit organizations. Creates the interim study committee on insurance and liability concerns of small nonprofit organizations (committee). Provides that the committee shall study insurance and liability issues affecting small nonprofit organizations and may prepare legislation for introduction in the 2007 session of the general assembly.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1367

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning civil procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006] (a) As used in this
2 SECTION, "small nonprofit organization" means an organization:
3 (1) with annual revenue of five hundred thousand dollars
4 (\$500,000) or less; and
5 (2) that is:
6 (A) tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
7 Revenue Code;
8 (B) a community mental retardation and other
9 developmental disabilities center (as defined in
10 IC 12-29-3-6);
11 (C) a rehabilitation center (as described in IC 12-12-3); or
12 (D) a faith based organization.
13 (b) The interim study committee on insurance and liability
14 concerns of small nonprofit organizations is established. The
15 committee shall study insurance and liability issues affecting small
16 nonprofit organizations and may prepare legislation for
17 introduction in the 2007 session of the general assembly.

1 (c) The committee shall operate under the policies governing
2 study committees adopted by the legislative council.

3 (d) The affirmative votes of a majority of the voting members
4 appointed to the committee are required for the committee to take
5 action on any measure, including final reports.

6 (e) This SECTION expires November 1, 2006.

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COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred House Bill 1367, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Page 1, line 1, delete "IC 34-30-5.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE".

Page 1, line 2, delete "AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS".

Page 1, line 3, delete "2006]:" and insert "2006]".

Page 1, delete lines 4 through 16.

Page 1, line 17, delete "Sec. 3." and insert "(a)".

Page 1, line 17, delete "chapter" and insert "SECTION,".

Page 1, run in lines 3 and 17.

Page 2, delete lines 12 through 16, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"(b) The interim study committee on insurance and liability concerns of small nonprofit organizations is established. The committee shall study insurance and liability issues affecting small nonprofit organizations and may prepare legislation for introduction in the 2007 session of the general assembly.

(c) The committee shall operate under the policies governing study committees adopted by the legislative council.

(d) The affirmative votes of a majority of the voting members appointed to the committee are required for the committee to take action on any measure, including final reports.

(e) This SECTION expires November 1, 2006."
