- 1 Page 1, line 6, delete "2016." and insert "**2011.**"
- 2 Page 1, line 8, delete "care".
- 3 Page 1, line 8, delete "2013," and insert "**2009,**".
- 4 Page 1, line 9, delete "2013," and insert "**2009,**".
- 5 Page 1, line 11, delete "2016." and insert "**2011.**".
- 6 Page 2, between lines 8 and 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 7 "SECTION 3. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006] (a) **As used in this**
- 8 **SECTION, "department" refers to the state department of health.**
- 9 (b) **The department shall implement disclosure guidelines for**
- 10 **health facilities that are licensed under IC 16-28 concerning**
- 11 **automatic fire sprinkler systems and smoke detectors, including the**
- 12 **following:**
- 13 (1) **The status of automatic fire sprinkler systems and smoke**
- 14 **detectors.**

- 1 **(2) The type of smoke detectors that are used.**
2 **(3) The plan of the health facility to install or update**
3 **automatic fire sprinkler systems and smoke detectors.**
4 **The disclosure guidelines may include Internet web site postings,**
5 **posting of information at health facilities, and providing**
6 **information to new clients of a health facility. However, the**
7 **disclosure guidelines must provide that any information that is**
8 **posted or distributed must be updated.**
9 **(c) This SECTION expires July 1, 2011."**
10 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to HB 1315 as introduced.)
