DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-20-6-2.

Synopsis: Permits for oversized or overweight vehicles. Requires a permit issued by the department of transportation for transporting an oversized or overweight vehicle and load to authorize the operation of the transporting vehicle from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset.

Effective: July 1, 2006.

SENATE BILL No. 133



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-20-6-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006]: Sec. 2. (a) The Indiana department of
- 3 transportation or local authority that:
- 4 (1) has jurisdiction over a highway or street; and
- 5 (2) is responsible for the repair and maintenance of the highway
- 6 or street;
- 7 may, upon proper application in writing and upon good cause shown,
- 8 grant a permit for transporting heavy vehicles and loads or other
- 9 objects not conforming to this article if the department or authority
- 10 finds that other traffic will not be seriously affected and the highway or
- 11 bridge will not be seriously damaged. **However, the permit must**
- 12 **authorize the operation of a vehicle subject to regulation under this**
- 13 **chapter from one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to one-half (1/2)**
- 14 **hour after sunset.**
- 15 (b) A permit may be issued under this section for the following:
- 16 (1) A single trip.
- 17 (2) A definite time not exceeding thirty (30) days.



- 1 (3) A ninety (90) day period.
- 2 (4) A one (1) year period.
