

# SENATE MOTION

**MADAM PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1106 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new  
2 paragraph and insert:  
3           "SECTION 1. IC 16-18-2-33.5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006]: Sec. 33.5. (a) "Basic life  
5 support", for purposes of IC 16-31, means the following:  
6           (1) Assessment of emergency patients.  
7           (2) Administration of oxygen.  
8           (3) Use of mechanical breathing devices.  
9           (4) Application of anti-shock trousers.  
10          (5) Performance of cardiopulmonary resuscitation.  
11          (6) Application of dressings and bandage materials.  
12          (7) Application of splinting and immobilization devices.  
13          (8) Use of lifting and moving devices to ensure safe transport.  
14          ~~(9) Use of an automatic or a semiautomatic defibrillator if the~~  
15          ~~defibrillator is used in accordance with training procedures~~  
16          ~~established by the Indiana emergency medical services~~  
17          ~~commission.~~  
18          ~~(+0) (9)~~ Administration by an emergency medical technician or  
19          emergency medical technician-basic advanced of epinephrine  
20          through an auto-injector.  
21          ~~(+1) (10)~~ For an emergency medical technician-basic advanced,  
22          the following:  
23                  (A) Electrocardiogram interpretation.  
24                  (B) Manual external defibrillation.  
25                  (C) Intravenous fluid therapy.  
26          ~~(+2) (11)~~ Other procedures authorized by the Indiana emergency  
27          medical services commission, including procedures contained in  
28          the revised national emergency medical technician basic training  
29          curriculum guide.  
30          (b) Except as provided by:

- 1 (1) subsection ~~(a)(10)~~ **(a)(9)** and the training and certification
- 2 standards established under ~~IC 16-31-2-9(4)~~; **IC 16-31-2-9(3)**;
- 3 (2) subsection ~~(a)(11)(C)~~; **(a)(10)(C)**; and
- 4 (3) the training standards established under ~~IC 16-31-2-9(5)~~;
- 5 **IC 16-31-2-9(4)**;

6 the term does not include invasive medical care techniques or advanced  
 7 life support.

8 SECTION 2. IC 16-31-2-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
 9 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006]: Sec. 9. The commission  
 10 shall establish the following:

- 11 (1) Standards for persons who provide emergency medical services
- 12 and who are not licensed or regulated under IC 16-31-3.
- 13 ~~(2) Training and certification standards for the use of automatic~~
- 14 ~~and semiautomatic defibrillators by first responders.~~
- 15 ~~(3) (2)~~ Training standards for the administration of antidotes,
- 16 vaccines, and antibiotics to prepare for or respond to a terrorist or
- 17 military attack.
- 18 ~~(4) (3)~~ Training and certification standards for the administration
- 19 of epinephrine through an auto-injector by:
- 20 (A) an emergency medical technician; or
- 21 (B) an emergency medical technician-basic advanced.
- 22 ~~(5) (4)~~ Training standards to permit the use of antidote kits
- 23 containing atropine and pralidoxime chloride for the treatment of
- 24 exposure to nerve agents by an emergency medical
- 25 technician-basic advanced, an emergency medical technician, or a
- 26 first responder.

27 SECTION 3. IC 16-31-3-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
 28 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006]: Sec. 1. (a) Except as  
 29 provided in subsection (b), a person other than:

- 30 (1) a licensed physician;
- 31 (2) a registered nurse or an individual acting under the supervision
- 32 of a licensed physician; or
- 33 (3) a person providing health care in a hospital or an ambulatory
- 34 outpatient surgical center licensed under IC 16-21;

35 may not furnish, operate, conduct, maintain, advertise, or otherwise be  
 36 engaged in providing emergency medical services, **except for the use**  
 37 **of an automated external defibrillator**, as a part of the regular course  
 38 of doing business, either paid or voluntary, unless that person holds a  
 39 valid certificate issued by the commission.

- 40 (b) A:
- 41 (1) licensed physician;
- 42 (2) registered nurse or an individual acting under the supervision
- 43 of a licensed physician; or
- 44 (3) person providing health care in a hospital or an ambulatory
- 45 outpatient surgical center licensed under IC 16-21;
- 46 who operates a business

1           (A) of transporting emergency patients by ambulance or  
2           (B) using a nontransporting emergency medical services  
3           vehicle  
4           must hold a valid certificate issued by the commission under this  
5           article."  
6           Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
