1 SECTION 1. That the Indiana State Senate urges the Legislative  
2 Council to assign and direct an interim or a statutory committee to  
3 study Indiana statutes pertaining to adverse possession.

4 SECTION 2. That the committee, should the topic be assigned by  
5 the Legislative Council, shall operate under the direction of the Council  
6 and shall issue a report when directed to do so by the Council.
