**Summary of Legislation:** This bill appropriates \$13,500 from the state General Fund to the Military Base Planning Council to pay the costs of a federal joint land-use study that would otherwise be imposed on local governments near Camp Atterbury.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2007.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** This bill appropriates \$13,500 from the state General Fund to the Military Base Planning Council. The money is to be used to pay the costs of a federal joint land-use study that would otherwise be imposed on local governments near Camp Atterbury. Money appropriated under the bill does not revert to the state General Fund at the close of any state fiscal year.

*Background Information:* The United States Office of Economic Adjustment reports that it estimates the cost of the joint land-use study to be \$135,000. Furthermore, the study is 90% federally funded and 10% locally funded. Thus, dollars appropriated under the bill would provide for coverage of dollars that would have otherwise been appropriated by local entities, including counties.
