Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill establishes the interim study Committee on Missing Children to study issues related to the location and recovery of missing children, including the use of DNA profiles, fingerprints, and technology to assist in the location of missing children.

Effective Date: July 1, 2007.

Explanation of State Expenditures: (Revised) This bill establishes the interim study Committee on Missing Children. The Committee is to operate under the policies governing study committees adopted by the Legislative Council. The bill does not provide a number of Committee members, thus, the size of the Committee could be greater or fewer than sixteen members. Legislative Council resolutions in the past have established budgets for interim study committees in the amount of \$9,500 per interim for committees with fewer than 16 members and \$16,500 for committees with 16 members or more.

The Committee expires December 31, 2007.
