HOUSE MOTION _____

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1479 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 6, between lines 20 and 21, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 7. IC 7.1-5-10-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007]: Sec. 1. (a) Except as
- 4 provided in subsection (d), it is unlawful to sell alcoholic beverages at
- 5 the following times:
- 6 (1) At a time other than that made lawful by the provisions of
- 7 IC 7.1-3-1-14.
- 8 (2) On Christmas Day and until 7:00 o'clock in the morning,
- 9 prevailing local time, the following day.
- 10 (3) On primary election day, and general election day, from 3:00
- 11 o'clock in the morning, prevailing local time, until ~~the voting polls~~
- 12 ~~are closed in the evening on these days:~~ **noon, prevailing local**
- 13 **time.**
- 14 (4) During a special election under IC 3-10-8-9 (within the
- 15 precincts where the special election is being conducted), from
- 16 3:00 o'clock in the morning until ~~the voting polls are closed in the~~
- 17 ~~evening on these days:~~ **noon, prevailing local time.**
- 18 (b) During the time when the sale of alcoholic beverages is
- 19 unlawful, no alcoholic beverages shall be sold, dispensed, given away,
- 20 or otherwise disposed of on the licensed premises and the licensed
- 21 premises shall remain closed to the extent that the nature of the
- 22 business carried on the premises, as at a hotel or restaurant, permits.
- 23 (c) It is unlawful to sell alcoholic beverages on New Years Day for
- 24 off-premises consumption.

1 (d) It is lawful for the holder of a valid beer, wine, or liquor
2 wholesaler's permit to sell to the holder of a valid retailer's or dealer's
3 permit at any time."

4 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
