Synopsis: Off-street parking on a certain state highway. Requires the Indiana department of transportation to restore street side parking at any location on State Road 22 where street side parking was eliminated by a road improvement project that was completed in calendar year 2006.

Effective: July 1, 2007.

HOUSE BILL No. 1140

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning utilities and transportation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007] (a) **The Indiana**
2 **department of transportation shall restore street side parking at**
3 **any location on State Road 22 where street side parking was**
4 **eliminated by a road improvement project that was completed in**
5 **calendar year 2006.**
6 (b) **This SECTION expires January 1, 2009.**
