HOUSE BILL No. 1255

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-16-1-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007]: Sec. 2. **(a)** The commission shall operate
3 or be responsible for the administration of all license branches in
4 Indiana under this article.
5 **(b) The commission shall operate at least one (1) full service**
6 **license branch in the city of Gary.**
