# COMMITTEE REPORT

## MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Interstate and International Cooperation, to which was referred House Bill 1280, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the following:
- 2 SECTION 1. IC 8-2.1-22-46, AS AMENDED BY P.L.1-2006,
- 3 SECTION 152, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 4 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007]: Sec. 46. (a) Notwithstanding any other
- 5 provision of this chapter, common and contract carriers and other
- 6 carriers engaged in the transportation of passengers or household goods
- 7 for hire, over regular or irregular routes, whether operating pursuant to
- 8 a certificate or permit or as an exempt carrier under section 2.1(5) of
- 9 this chapter, shall file with the department proof of financial
- 10 responsibility in the form of surety bonds or policies of insurance or
- 11 shall qualify as a self-insured. The minimum level of financial
- 12 responsibility required shall be **as follows:**
- 13 **(1) For contract carriers other than those described in**
- 14 **subdivision (2), the minimum level established under ~~49 U.S.C.~~**

1           ~~13906(a)(1)~~ **49 U.S.C. 31138.**  
2           **(2) For contract carriers that transport railroad employees,**  
3           **at least five million dollars (\$5,000,000).**

4           (b) A person who violates this section commits a Class C infraction.  
5           However, the offense is a Class A misdemeanor if the person has a  
6           prior unrelated judgment for violating this section.

7           (c) In addition to any other penalty imposed upon a person for a  
8           conviction of a Class A misdemeanor under subsection (b), the law  
9           enforcement agency may impound the vehicles owned by the person.  
10          Unless the vehicle is impounded or forfeited under a law other than this  
11          section, the vehicle shall be released to the carrier when the carrier  
12          complies with this section.
