A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007] **Sec. 1. (a) As used in**
- 2 **this SECTION, "committee" refers to the interim study committee**
- 3 **on Title IV-D and child support established by this SECTION.**
- 4 **(b) There is established the interim study committee on Title**
- 5 **IV-D and child support. The committee shall study issues that**
- 6 **relate to child support and Title IV-D, including issues concerning**
- 7 **the ability of a prosecuting attorney to adjust child support without**
- 8 **a hearing as described in 42 U.S.C. 666.**
- 9 **(c) The committee shall operate under the policies governing**
- 10 **study committees adopted by the legislative council.**
- 11 **(d) The affirmative votes of a majority of the voting members**
- 12 **appointed to the committee are required for the committee to take**
- 13 **action on any measure, including final reports.**
- 14 **(e) This SECTION expires November 1, 2007.**
