DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Funding for joint land use study. Appropriates \$13,500 from the state general fund to the military base planning council to pay the costs of a federal joint land use study that would otherwise be imposed on local governments near Camp Atterbury.

HOUSE BILL No. 1695

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning land use and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007] (a) There is
2 appropriated to the military base planning council established by
3 IC 4-3-21-3 thirteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$13,500) from
4 the state general fund to pay the costs of a federal joint land use
5 study that would otherwise be imposed on local governments near
6 Camp Atterbury.
7 (b) The money appropriated by this SECTION does not revert
8 to the state general fund at the close of any state fiscal year but
9 remains available to the military base planning council until the
10 purpose for which it was appropriated is fulfilled.
