HOUSE BILL No. 1778

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 31-9-2-31, AS AMENDED BY P.L.146-2006,
2 SECTION 12, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2007]: Sec. 31. (a) "Custodian", for purposes of the juvenile
4 law, means a person with whom a child resides.

5 (b) "Custodian", for purposes of IC 31-34-1, includes any person
6 who is:

- 7 (1) a license applicant or licensee of:
8 (A) a foster home or residential child care facility that is
9 required to be licensed or is licensed under IC 31-27;
10 (B) a child care center that is required to be licensed or is
11 licensed under IC 12-17.2-4; or
12 (C) a child care home that is required to be licensed or is
13 licensed under IC 12-17.2-5; or

14 (2) a person who is responsible for care, supervision, or welfare
15 of children while providing services as an employee or volunteer
16 at:

- 17 (A) a home, center, or facility described in subdivision (1);
