Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill requires that the court suspend the license of a person for five to ten years if the person, within a five-year period, has three convictions or judgments for operating a motor vehicle without proper insurance. It requires that the court suspend the license of a person for ten years if the person, without proper insurance, is involved in an accident causing the death of another person and has a prior judgment or conviction for driving without insurance in the previous five years.

Effective Date: July 1, 2008.

Explanation of State Expenditures: For the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV), the suspensions required in this proposal will be handled under current suspension procedures with no additional fiscal impact. The fund affected is the Motor Vehicle Highway Account which supports the BMV.
