DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-45-2-6.

Synopsis: 911 call mischief. Makes it a Class A misdemeanor to make a 911 call in a manner that is offensively repetitive, that delays a response to an emergency, or that causes harm to a person or property.

Effective: July 1, 2008.

HOUSE BILL No. 1123

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-45-2-6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2008]: **Sec. 6. A person who knowingly or intentionally places a
4 911 call that:**
5 (1) **does not concern an emergency; and**
6 (2) **is:**
7 (A) **made in an offensively repetitive manner;**
8 (B) **a cause of a delay in response to an emergency; or**
9 (C) **a cause of harm to a person or property;**
10 **commits 911 call mischief, a Class A misdemeanor.**
