

HOUSE BILL No. 1295

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-29-5; IC 16-41-42-3.

Synopsis: Fees for spinal cord and brain injury fund. Provides for a fee of fifty cents to be collected after December 31, 2008, for registration of certain vehicles, to be deposited in the spinal cord and brain injury fund. Revises the fee for registration of a motorcycle.

Effective: July 1, 2008.

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January 15, 2008, read first time and referred to Committee on Roads and Transportation.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1295



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-29-5-0.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 3 1, 2008]: **Sec. 0.5. (a) This section applies after December 31, 2008.**
- 4 **(b) In addition to the fees to be collected for the registration of**
- 5 **a vehicle as set forth in:**
- 6 (1) IC 9-29-5-1;
- 7 (2) IC 9-29-5-2;
- 8 (3) IC 9-29-5-3;
- 9 (4) IC 9-29-5-5;
- 10 (5) IC 9-29-5-7;
- 11 (6) IC 9-29-5-8;
- 12 (7) IC 9-29-5-9;
- 13 (8) IC 9-29-5-10;
- 14 (9) IC 9-29-5-18;
- 15 (10) IC 9-29-5-28;
- 16 (11) IC 9-29-5-30; and
- 17 (12) IC 9-29-5-31;

5 SECTION 2. IC 9-29-5-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS

7 passenger motor vehicle is twelve dollars (~~\$12~~); and fifty cents
8 (\$12.50), including after December 31, 2008, the fee set forth in
9 section 0.5(b) of this chapter.

10 SECTION 3. IC 9-29-5-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.234-2007,
11 SECTION 43, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
12 JULY 1, 2008]: Sec. 2. (a) This subsection expires December 31,
13 2008. The fee for the registration of a motorcycle is twenty-seven
14 dollars (\$27). The revenue from this fee shall be allocated as follows:

- 15 (1) Seven dollars (\$7) to the motorcycle operator safety education
16 fund established by IC 20-30-13-11.
- 17 (2) An amount prescribed as a license branch service charge
18 under IC 9-29-3.
- 19 (3) Ten dollars (\$10) to the spinal cord and brain injury fund
20 under IC 16-41-42-4.
- 21 (4) The balance to the state general fund for credit to the motor
22 vehicle highway account.

23 (b) This subsection applies after December 31, 2008. The fee for
24 the registration of a motorcycle is seventeen dollars and fifty cents
25 (\$17.50). The revenue from this fee shall be allocated as follows:

- 26 (1) Seven dollars (\$7) to the motorcycle operator safety
27 education fund established by IC 20-30-13-11.
- 28 (2) An amount prescribed as a license branch service charge
29 under IC 9-29-3.
- 30 (3) Fifty cents (\$0.50) to the spinal cord and brain injury fund
31 under IC 16-41-42-3.
- 32 (4) The balance to the state general fund for credit to the
33 motor vehicle highway account.

34 SECTION 4. IC 9-29-5-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
35 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008]: Sec. 3. (a) Except as otherwise provided
36 in this chapter, the annual registration fee for:

- 37 (1) a truck subject to registration under IC 9-18; and
- 38 (2) a tractor not used with a semitrailer, a traction engine, or other
39 similar vehicle used for hauling purposes;

SECTION 5. IC 9-29-5-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008]: Sec. 5. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, the annual registration fee for a tractor used with a semitrailer is as follows, based on the declared gross weight of the tractor semitrailer combination:

 30 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008]: Sec. 8. The annual registration fee for a
 31 school bus is twenty dollars (~~\$20~~) **and fifty cents (\$20.50), including**
 32 **after December 31, 2008, the fee set forth in section 0.5(b) of this**
 33 **chapter.**

34 SECTION 8. IC 9-29-5-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS

 5 section, "other bus" means a bus that is not a church bus, an intercity
 6 bus, an intracity bus, or a school bus.
 7 (b) The annual registration fee for any other bus is thirty dollars
 8 ~~(\$30).~~ **and fifty cents (\$30.50), including after December 31, 2008,**
 9 **the fee set forth in section 0.5(b) of this chapter.**
 10 SECTION 10. IC 9-29-5-18 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 11 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008]: Sec. 18. The fee for a
 12 recreational vehicle is twenty dollars ~~(\$20).~~ **and fifty cents (\$20.50),**
 13 **including after December 31, 2008, the fee set forth in section**
 14 **0.5(b) of this chapter.**
 15 SECTION 11. IC 9-29-5-28, AS AMENDED BY P.L.79-2006,
 16 SECTION 7, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 17 JULY 1, 2008]: Sec. 28. Except as provided in IC 9-29-12-2.5(e) and
 18 section 32.5 of this chapter, the registration fee for an antique motor
 19 vehicle under IC 9-18-12 is twelve dollars ~~(\$12).~~ **and fifty cents**
 20 **(\$12.50), including after December 31, 2008, the fee set forth in**
 21 **section 0.5(b) of this chapter.**
 22 SECTION 12. IC 9-29-5-30 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 23 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008]: Sec. 30. (a) The registration
 24 fee for a recovery vehicle under IC 9-18-13 is as follows:
 25 (1) Class A recovery vehicle, five hundred dollars (\$500).
 26 (2) Class B recovery vehicle, seventy-five dollars (\$75).
 27 (b) A vehicle registered under IC 9-18-13 is not subject to any other
 28 registration fee under IC 9-18. However, a vehicle registered under
 29 IC 9-18-13 is subject to a tax or service charge **and, after December**
 30 **31, 2008, the fee set forth in section 0.5(b) of this chapter** imposed
 31 on a vehicle registered under this title.
 32 SECTION 13. IC 9-29-5-31 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 33 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008]: Sec. 31. (a) The registration
 34 fee for a military vehicle under IC 9-18-14 is twelve dollars ~~(\$12).~~ **and**
 35 **fifty cents (\$12.50), including after December 31, 2008, the fee set**
 36 **forth in section 0.5(b) of this chapter.**
 37 (b) The bureau shall collect the fee in subsection (a) in addition to
 38 any excise tax imposed under IC 6-6-5.
 39 SECTION 14. IC 16-41-42-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.234-2007,
 40 SECTION 47, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 41 JULY 1, 2008]: Sec. 3. (a) The spinal cord and brain injury fund is
 42 established to fund research on spinal cord and brain injuries.

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- 1 (b) The fund shall be administered by the state department.
- 2 (c) The fund consists of:
- 3 (1) appropriations;
- 4 (2) gifts and bequests;
- 5 (3) fees deposited in the fund under:
- 6 (A) IC 9-29-5-2 **through December 31, 2008**; and
- 7 (B) **beginning January 1, 2009, IC 9-29-5-0.5**; and
- 8 (4) grants received from the federal government or private
- 9 sources.
- 10 (d) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from
- 11 money in the fund.
- 12 (e) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not
- 13 currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
- 14 manner as other public money may be invested.
- 15 (f) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not revert
- 16 to the state general fund.
- 17 (g) **All** of the money in the fund is continually appropriated to the
- 18 state department to fund spinal cord and brain injury research
- 19 programs.

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
