## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 30-2-12-13.5.

**Synopsis:** Donor withdrawal of property from institutions. Allows a donor to an institutional fund to petition a court for withdrawal of donated property from the institution if the institution is not managing or distributing the property in a manner consistent with the donor's intention.

**Effective:** July 1, 2008.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning trusts and fiduciaries.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 30-2-12-13.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008]: **Sec. 13.5. The donor identified in the**  
4 **gift instrument may petition a court to withdraw the donated**  
5 **property from the institution if the institution is not managing or**  
6 **distributing the property in a manner consistent with the donor's**  
7 **intention.**
