Summary of Legislation: Requires the office of Medicaid policy and planning to suspend rather than terminate a child's Medicaid eligibility if the child has been adjudicated to be a delinquent child and has been placed in specified facilities. Requires the individual, for-profit or nonprofit entity, or governmental entity operating the facility in which the child is placed to take action necessary to ensure the child is eligible for Medicaid when the child is released from the facility.

Effective Date: Upon passage; July
