Summary of Legislation: Provides annually for a supplemental benefit (computed using the consumer price index (United States city average) prepared by the United States Department of Labor) for retired members of the state police 1987 benefit system whose basic monthly pension amount is less than the basic monthly pension amount payable to a retired state police employee in the grade of a trooper who has completed 25 years of service as of July 1 of that year. Appropriates annually to the state police department from the state general fund an amount sufficient to pay the supplemental benefits.
