Summary of Legislation: This bill prohibits public schools and accredited nonpublic schools from beginning student instructional days for the school year before the first Monday in September (Labor Day) and from extending the school year beyond June 15, beginning with the 2010-2011 school year. It makes an exception for year-round schools.

Effective Date: July 1, 2009.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill should have no impact on state expenditures. Schools would still be required to have at least 180 days of instruction per year.

Explanation of State Revenues:
