Summary of Legislation: The bill requires that a board of trustees of a regional water, sewage, or solid waste district be elected. The bill requires that each unit included in the district be represented on the board. The bill repeals provisions that allow appointments to a board.

Effective Date: July 1, 2009; January 1, 2010.
