**IMPACT:** State

**Summary of Legislation:** (Amended) This bill has the following provisions:

- A. *Time of Death Penalty Execution* – It removes the requirement that a death penalty execution occur before the hour of sunrise on the execution date.
- B. *Housing Death Row Inmates* – It requires the Sentencing Policy Study Committee to study the issue of housing death row inmates in a facility other than the Indiana State Prison.

**Effective Date:** (Amended) Upon passage; July 1, 2009.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** *Time of Death Penalty Execution* – No fiscal impact.

(Revised) *Housing Death Row Inmates* – The Sentencing Policy Study Committee is a 20-member study committee composed of four legislators and other persons representing the judiciary, prosecuting attorneys, criminal defense attorneys, community corrections officials, and other groups working in criminal justice.
