Summary of Legislation: This bill permits a local authority to regulate the solicitation of monetary donations on private roads and highways under the local authority's jurisdiction, including requiring a person who solicits a monetary donation to first obtain a permit.

Effective Date: July 1, 2009.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: Local units have the authority to regulate private roads and highways under their jurisdiction already. This proposal adds a new responsibility. There may be additional expenditures attached to this responsibility, but the level is not known and will depend upon the number of private roads and highways in a particular jurisdiction.

Explanation of Local Revenues: There may be revenue accruing to the local unit, depending upon the cost of a permit and the number of such permits issued.
