**Summary of Legislation:** This bill permits a local authority to regulate the solicitation of monetary donations on private roads and highways under the local authority's jurisdiction, including requiring a person who solicits a monetary donation to first obtain a permit.

**Explanation of Local Expenditures:** Local units have the authority to regulate private roads and highways under their jurisdiction already. This proposal adds a new responsibility. There may be additional expenditures attached to this responsibility, but the level is not known and will depend upon the number of private roads and highways in a particular jurisdiction.
