MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 86 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 7, delete lines 6 through 42.
- 2 Delete pages 8 through 17.
- 3 Page 18, delete line 1.
- 4 Page 21, between lines 17 and 18, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 5 "SECTION 8. IC 25-22.5-2-7, AS AMENDED BY P.L.225-2007,
- 6 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 7 JULY 1, 2009]: Sec. 7. (a) The board shall do the following:
- 8 (1) Adopt rules and forms necessary to implement this article that
- 9 concern, but are not limited to, the following areas:
- 10 (A) Qualification by education, residence, citizenship,
- 11 training, and character for admission to an examination for
- 12 licensure or by endorsement for licensure.
- 13 (B) The examination for licensure.
- 14 (C) The license or permit.
- 15 (D) Fees for examination, permit, licensure, and registration.
- 16 (E) Reinstatement of licenses and permits.
- 17 (F) Payment of costs in disciplinary proceedings conducted by
- 18 the board.
- 19 (2) Administer oaths in matters relating to the discharge of its
- 20 official duties.
- 21 (3) Enforce this article and assign to the personnel of the agency
- 22 duties as may be necessary in the discharge of the board's duty.
- 23 (4) Maintain, through the agency, full and complete records of all
- 24 applicants for licensure or permit and of all licenses and permits

- 1 issued.
- 2 (5) Make available, upon request, the complete schedule of
3 minimum requirements for licensure or permit.
- 4 (6) Issue, at the board's discretion, a temporary permit to an
5 applicant for the interim from the date of application until the
6 next regular meeting of the board.
- 7 (7) Issue an unlimited license, a limited license, or a temporary
8 medical permit, depending upon the qualifications of the
9 applicant, to any applicant who successfully fulfills all of the
10 requirements of this article.
- 11 (8) Adopt rules establishing standards for the competent practice
12 of medicine, osteopathic medicine, or any other form of practice
13 regulated by a limited license or permit issued under this article.
- 14 (9) Adopt rules regarding the appropriate prescribing of Schedule
15 III or Schedule IV controlled substances for the purpose of weight
16 reduction or to control obesity.
- 17 (10) Adopt rules establishing standards for office based
18 procedures that require moderate sedation, deep sedation, or
19 general anesthesia.
- 20 (b) The board may adopt rules that establish:
- 21 (1) certification requirements for child death pathologists;
22 (2) an annual training program for child death pathologists under
23 IC 16-35-7-3(b)(2); and
24 (3) a process to certify a qualified child death pathologist.
- 25 (c) **The board:**
- 26 (1) **shall license certified direct entry midwives in accordance**
27 **with IC 25-23.4; and**
- 28 (2) **may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to implement this**
29 **subsection and IC 25-23.4."**
- 30 Page 22, line 29, delete "midwifery board established by" and insert
31 "**medical licensing board created by IC 25-22.5-2-1.**".
- 32 Page 22, delete line 30.
- 33 Page 23, line 21, delete "Midwifery Board" and insert "**Licensure**
