# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1172 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 5, after line 15, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 3. IC 4-23-28-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.1-2006,
- 3 SECTION 84, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 2009]: Sec. 4. (a) The commission consists of twenty (20)
- 5 members appointed as follows:
- 6 (1) Two (2) members of the senate who may not be affiliated with
- 7 the same political party, to be appointed by the president pro
- 8 tempore of the senate.
- 9 (2) Two (2) members of the house of representatives who may not
- 10 be affiliated with the same political party, to be appointed by the
- 11 speaker of the house of representatives.
- 12 (3) Four (4) members of the Hispanic/Latino community who are
- 13 not members of the general assembly, to be appointed by the
- 14 president pro tempore of the senate.
- 15 (4) Four (4) members of the Hispanic/Latino community who are
- 16 not members of the general assembly, to be appointed by the
- 17 speaker of the house of representatives.
- 18 (5) The secretary of family and social services or a designee of the
- 19 secretary who is a Hispanic or Latino employee of the office of
- 20 the secretary of family and social services.
- 21 (6) The commissioner of the state department of health or a
- 22 designee of the commissioner who is a Hispanic or Latino
- 23 employee of the state department of health.
- 24 (7) The state superintendent of public instruction or a designee of

- 1 the superintendent who is a Hispanic or Latino employee of the  
 2 department of education.
- 3 (8) The commissioner of the department of correction or a  
 4 designee of the commissioner who is a Hispanic or Latino  
 5 employee of the department of correction.
- 6 (9) The director of the civil rights commission or a designee of the  
 7 director who is a Hispanic or Latino employee of the civil rights  
 8 commission.
- 9 (10) The lieutenant governor or a designee of the lieutenant  
 10 governor who is a Hispanic or Latino employee of the lieutenant  
 11 governor.
- 12 (11) A Hispanic or Latino business person, appointed by the  
 13 governor.
- 14 (12) The commissioner of workforce development or a designee  
 15 of the commissioner who is a Hispanic or Latino employee of the  
 16 department of workforce development, who shall serve as an ex  
 17 officio member of the commission.

18 In making their appointments under this section, the president pro  
 19 tempore of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives  
 20 shall attempt to have the greatest possible number of counties  
 21 represented on the commission.

22 **(b) The members appointed under subsection (a)(5) through**  
 23 **(a)(9) and subsection (a)(12) are nonvoting members of the**  
 24 **commission.**

25 ~~(b)~~ (c) If a legislative member of the commission ceases to be a  
 26 member of the chamber from which the member was appointed, the  
 27 member also ceases to be a member of the commission.

28 ~~(c)~~ (d) A member of the commission may be removed at any time  
 29 by the appointing authority who appointed the member.

30 ~~(d)~~ (e) If a vacancy on the commission occurs, the appointing  
 31 authority who appointed the former member whose position has  
 32 become vacant shall appoint an individual to fill the vacancy.

33 SECTION 4. IC 4-23-28-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
 34 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2009]: Sec. 8. The affirmative votes

1 of a majority of the **voting** members appointed to the commission are  
2 required for the commission to take action on any measure, including  
3 final reports.".

4 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
