DIGEST OF HB 1100 (Updated February 16, 2010 11:10 am - DI 106)

Citations Affected: IC 35-44; noncode.

Synopsis: Inmate possession of a cellular device prohibited. Makes it a Class A misdemeanor for a person incarcerated in a county jail to possess a cellular telephone or other wireless or cellular communications device.

Effective: July 1, 2010.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1100

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-44-3-9.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2010]: **Sec. 9.6. A person who knowingly or intentionally**
4 **possesses a cellular telephone or other wireless or cellular**
5 **communications device while incarcerated in a county jail commits**
6 **a Class A misdemeanor.**

7 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010] **IC 35-44-3-9.6, as**
8 **added by this act, applies only to crimes committed after June 30,**
9 **2010.**
