Summary of Legislation: This bill allows the holder of a retailer's permit to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises from Sunday at 10 a.m. until Monday at 3 a.m.. (Under current law, retailers can sell alcoholic beverages until 3 a.m. all other days of the week.)

Effective Date: July 1, 2010.

Explanation of State Expenditures:

Explanation of State Revenues: This bill allows the holder of a retailer's permit to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises from Sunday at 10 a.m. until Monday at 3 a.m. Under current law, retailers can only sell alcohol beverages until Monday at 12:30 a.m. This provision should have little to no impact on revenue, since any additional purchases of alcohol would likely reduce consumer spending on other sales taxable items.
