

# COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Pursuant to Joint Rule 20, your Committee on Rules and Legislative Procedures, to which was referred Engrossed Senate Bill 281 because it conflicts with HEA 1068-2010 without properly recognizing the existence of HEA 1068-2010, has had Engrossed Senate Bill 281 under consideration and begs leave to report back to the House with the recommendation that Engrossed Senate Bill 281 be corrected as follows:

- 1           Page 4, line 28, delete "P.L.155-2007," and insert "HEA 1068-2010,
- 2           SECTION 1,".
- 3           Page 4, line 29, delete "SECTION 1,".
- 4           Page 8, between lines 10 and 11, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 5           "(l) Except as provided in subsection (m), for purposes of
- 6           IC 5-14-3-4(a)(1), the following information is confidential, may not
- 7           be published, and is not open to public inspection:
- 8           (1) Information submitted by a person under this section to:
- 9           (A) obtain; or
- 10           (B) renew;
- 11           a license to carry a handgun.
- 12           (2) Information obtained by a federal, state, or local government
- 13           entity in the course of an investigation concerning a person who
- 14           applies to:
- 15           (A) obtain; or
- 16           (B) renew;
- 17           a license to carry a handgun issued under this chapter.
- 18           (3) The name, address, and any other information that may be
- 19           used to identify a person who holds a license to carry a handgun
- 20           issued under this chapter.
- 21           (m) Notwithstanding subsection (l):
- 22           (1) any information concerning an applicant for or a person who
- 23           holds a license to carry a handgun issued under this chapter may
- 24           be released to a federal, state, or local government entity:
- 25           (A) for law enforcement purposes; or

1           (B) to determine the validity of a license to carry a handgun;  
2           and  
3           (2) general information concerning the issuance of licenses to  
4           carry handguns in Indiana may be released to a person conducting  
5           journalistic or academic research, but only if all personal  
6           information that could disclose the identity of any person who  
7           holds a license to carry a handgun issued under this chapter has  
8           been removed from the general information."
