**Synopsis:** Fishing licenses for discharged veterans. Allows a resident who has served during the preceding 24 months in federal active service outside the United States as a member of the armed forces to fish without a license.

## SENATE BILL No. 386



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 14-22-11-11 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 11. (a) A resident of  
3 Indiana on leave from the armed forces of the United States may hunt  
4 or fish any species in season without a license for the duration of the  
5 person's leave. However, when the person is hunting or fishing, the  
6 person must show the person's leave orders and motor vehicle  
7 operator's license or voter registration card to prove residence in  
8 Indiana to a law enforcement officer requesting to see the leave orders  
9 and license or card.

- 10 (b) A resident of Indiana who:  
11 (1) has served at any time during the preceding twenty-four  
12 (24) months in federal active service outside the United States  
13 as:  
14 (A) a member of the National Guard; or  
15 (B) a reserve or active duty member of the armed forces of  
16 the United States; and  
17 (2) has been discharged from active duty;



1        **may fish any species in season without a license. However, when**  
2        **the person is fishing, the person must show the person's official**  
3        **military discharge papers and motor vehicle operator's license or**  
4        **voter registration card to prove residence in Indiana to a law**  
5        **enforcement officer requesting to see the discharge papers and**  
6        **license or card.**
