

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 240 be amended to read as follows:

- 21 "SECTION 6. IC 36-6-6-10, AS AMENDED BY P.L.146-2008,
- 22 SECTION 713, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 23 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 10. (a) This section does not apply
- 24 to the appropriation of money to pay a deputy or an employee of a
- 25 township assessor with assessment duties or to an elected township
- 26 assessor.
- 27 (b) The township legislative body shall fix the:
- 28 (1) salaries;
- 29 (2) wages;
- 30 (3) rates of hourly pay; and
- 31 (4) remuneration other than statutory allowances;

1 of all officers and employees of the township.

2 (c) Subject to subsection (d), the township legislative body may
3 reduce the salary of an elected or appointed official. However, except
4 as provided in subsection (h), the official is entitled to a salary that is
5 not less than the salary fixed for the first year of the term of office that
6 immediately preceded the current term of office.

7 (d) Except as provided in subsection (h), the township legislative
8 body may not alter the salaries of elected or appointed officers during
9 the fiscal year for which they are fixed, but it may add or eliminate any
10 other position and change the salary of any other employee, if the
11 necessary funds and appropriations are available.

12 (e) If a change in the mileage allowance paid to state officers and
13 employees is established by July 1 of any year, that change shall be
14 included in the compensation fixed for the township executive and
15 assessor under this section, to take effect January 1 of the next year.
16 However, the township legislative body may by ordinance provide for
17 the change in the sum per mile to take effect before January 1 of the
18 next year.

19 (f) The township legislative body may not reduce the salary of the
20 township executive without the consent of the township executive
21 during the term of office of the township executive as set forth in
22 IC 36-6-4-2.

23 (g) This subsection applies when a township executive dies or
24 resigns from office. The person filling the vacancy of the township
25 executive shall receive at least the same salary the previous township
26 executive received for the remainder of the unexpired term of office of
27 the township executive (as set forth in IC 36-6-4-2), unless the person
28 consents to a reduction in salary.

29 (h) In a year in which there is not an election of members to the
30 township legislative body, the township legislative body may by
31 unanimous vote reduce the salaries of the members of the township
32 legislative body by any amount.

33 **(i) The salary paid to a township board member after December**
34 **31, 2014, may not exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) each year."**
