

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 240 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 16, delete lines 19 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:
3 "SECTION 16. IC 36-6-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
4 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
5 JULY 1, 2010]:
6 **Chapter 9. Employment of Relatives**
7 **Sec. 1. This chapter does not apply to an individual who:**
8 **(1) is a contractor or employed by a contractor for the design**
9 **or construction of a township public works project;**
10 **(2) is a vendor or employed by a vendor for a township**
11 **purchase of supplies;**
12 **(3) is a vendor or employed by a vendor for a township**
13 **purchase of mowing services or property maintenance**
14 **services; or**
15 **(4) is a member of a paid fire department or a volunteer fire**
16 **department that renders fire protection services to the**
17 **township.**
18 **Sec. 2. (a) As used in this chapter, "relative" means:**
19 **(1) a husband;**
20 **(2) a wife;**
21 **(3) a father, grandfather, or stepfather;**
22 **(4) a mother, grandmother, or stepmother;**
23 **(5) a son, grandson, stepson, or son-in-law;**
24 **(6) a daughter, granddaughter, stepdaughter, or**
25 **daughter-in-law;**
26 **(7) a brother or stepbrother;**
27 **(8) a sister or stepsister;**
28 **(9) an aunt;**
29 **(10) an uncle;**
30 **(11) a niece;**
31 **(12) a nephew; or**

(13) a first cousin.

(b) A relative by adoption, half-blood, marriage, or remarriage shall be treated as a relative of whole kinship for purposes of this chapter.

Sec. 3. Except as provided in section 4 of this chapter, an individual who is a relative of a township officer or a township employee may not be an employee of the township.

Sec. 4. A person who on July 1, 2010:

(1) is a relative of a township officer or a township employee;

and

(2) is employed by the township;

is not prohibited by this chapter, until the expiration of the current term of office of the township executive holding office on July 1, 2010, from being an employee of the township."
