

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1086 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 54, between lines 29 and 30, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 51. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **(a) The interim**
3 **study committee on economic development is established to study**
4 **the following:**
- 5 **(1) Best practices in state and local economic development**
6 **policies and activities.**
 - 7 **(2) The use and effectiveness of tax credits and deductions.**
 - 8 **(3) Whether there are any specific sectors of the economy for**
9 **which Indiana might have comparative advantages over other**
10 **states.**
 - 11 **(4) The extent to which Indiana's tax laws encourage business**
12 **investment, and any improvements that might be made to**
13 **Indiana's tax laws.**
 - 14 **(5) The extent to which Indiana's education systems support**
15 **economic development.**
 - 16 **(6) The benefits of existing community revitalization**
17 **enhancement districts and possible new community**
18 **revitalization enhancement districts as an economic**
19 **development tool.**
 - 20 **(7) Any other issue assigned to the committee by the**
21 **legislative council or as directed by the committee's co-chairs.**
- 22 **(b) The committee consists of the following members:**
- 23 **(1) Two (2) members of the senate, who must be affiliated**
24 **with different political parties, appointed by the president pro**
25 **tempore of the senate.**
 - 26 **(2) Two (2) members of the house of representatives, who**
27 **must be affiliated with different political parties, appointed by**
28 **the speaker of the house of representatives.**
 - 29 **(3) The chief executive officer of the Indiana economic**
30 **development corporation (or the chief executive officer's**

- 1 **designee).**
- 2 **(4) The following twelve (12) members appointed by the**
- 3 **governor, not more than six (6) of whom may be affiliated**
- 4 **with the same political party:**
- 5 **(A) One (1) member to represent large businesses.**
- 6 **(B) One (1) member to represent small businesses.**
- 7 **(C) One (1) member to represent banking and finance.**
- 8 **(D) One (1) member to represent labor interests.**
- 9 **(E) One (1) member to represent higher education.**
- 10 **(F) One (1) member to represent local economic**
- 11 **development organizations and officials.**
- 12 **(G) One (1) member to represent cities.**
- 13 **(H) One (1) member to represent counties.**
- 14 **(I) One (1) member to represent agricultural interests.**
- 15 **(J) One (1) member to represent the public at large.**
- 16 **(K) One (1) member to represent kindergarten through**
- 17 **grade 12 education.**
- 18 **(L) One (1) member to represent the arts and humanities.**
- 19 **(c) The president pro tempore of the senate shall appoint one (1)**
- 20 **of the members appointed by the president as a co-chair of the**
- 21 **committee. The speaker of the house of representatives shall**
- 22 **appoint one (1) of the members appointed by the speaker as a**
- 23 **co-chair of the committee.**
- 24 **(d) The committee shall issue a final report in an electronic**
- 25 **format under IC 5-14-6 before November 1, 2010, to the legislative**
- 26 **council containing any findings and recommendations of the**
- 27 **committee.**
- 28 **(e) Except as otherwise provided, the committee shall operate**
- 29 **under the policies governing study committees adopted by the**
- 30 **legislative council.**
- 31 **(f) The affirmative votes of a majority of the voting members**
- 32 **appointed to the committee are required for the committee to take**
- 33 **action on any measure, including final reports.**
- 34 **(g) This SECTION expires January 1, 2011."**
- 35 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
